



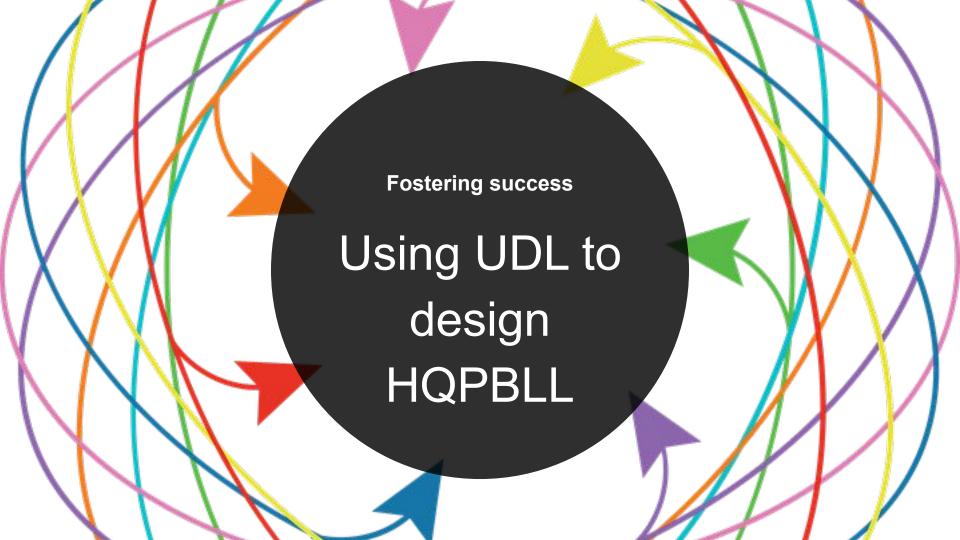

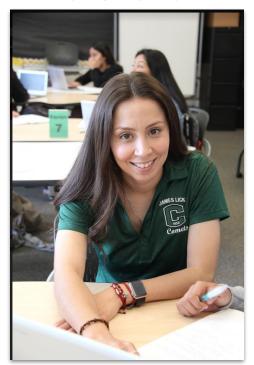

Universal Design for Learning to support HQPBLL



Assumptions and Beliefs that Ground UDL

- 1. Barriers are embedded and layered and are usually a function of the design
- Learners need options & choice
- 3. Variability is expected and embraced
- 4. Developing learner expertise is a right
- 5. Separate learning goals from skill goals supports all learners
